W3 Candle Care & Safety

- » Safety first, enjoyment follows. Please use common sense while burning candles.
- » The most important burn in a candle's life is the very first burn. Burn candles to the rim or outer edge.
- » Only burn candles on a stable, heat safe surface, dish or holder.
- » Never leave candles burning unattended. Always burn insight.
- » Keep candles out of reach of children and pets.
- » Mind a burning candle's surroundings. Avoid flammable objects like drapes, towels, wallpaper, botanicals, artwork, etc.

We only use all cotton wicks.

Our fragrant pillar candles are hand-poured in the tradition of the Old World. Upon keeping this heritage, the vintage pillar candles are transitioning to behold the traditional subtle 'Beeswax Color' of the Old World.

All West Third Brand candles are poured at very high fragrance ratios. Due to the significant fragrances levels this may cause candles to weep oil and unavoidable dispersion of fragrance oil onto the wax paper of the vintage pillar candles.

Most of our products are made by hand. Imperfections will occur and in this is where we find true beauty.

- » Always and often trim wicks, this assists in the candles performance and also increases the candles life.
- » Extinguish candles with a snuffer.
- » Never burn candles in a draft as it may cause the candle to burn unevenly, soot, smoke and drip.
- » Fading or discoloring may happen over time or when candles are exposed to harsh light. Avoid placing candles in windows including indirect sunlight and bright interior lights.
- » Always store candles in a cool, dry place.
- » Remove all flammable paper and plastic packaging on the pillar candles before lighting.
